I am disturbed by the public notice I read in the Nisqually Valley News regarding the issue of water supply in the City of Yelm and by extension its potential affect to the outlying areas.

Considering the evidence presented by JZ Knight and confirmed by the WA Dept of Ecology that the city of Yelm had already been exceeding its allotted water rights for the past several years, it is unconscionable that the city continues to approve additional residential and commercial developments without thought to the adequacy of a very necessary resource for basic living. While I understand the city's desire for continued growth and prosperity, it must do so responsibly, lawfully and most certainly, not at the risk of its citizens' health and welfare.

The city of Yelm should provide nothing less than a thorough Environmental Impact Statement to the courts for review (per their ruling) and that such an important issue be put forth to the public for discussion.
