As a resident of the greater community area I would like to file this official appeal for The City of Yelm officials to meet their obligation for an EIS to be done for the proposed new water plan. As a local resident (whose well is shallow) I don't think the burden of proof of the need for compliance falls on me, for the need was already thoroughly and officially substantiated in the process of making the law. As elected officials whose responsibility it is to uphold the existing laws, if you do not do so, are you willing and able to take full financial responsibility, as individuals - since you are intending to skirt the law, for the potential repercussions for noncompliance?

To undertake such a significant change in water usage for the entire area and then choose to bypass the critical evaluation mandated by law seems to be gross negligence of your official responsibilities.
