After reading this advertisement on the web, <http://www.jzknight.com/download/WaterIssue.pdf> , it is apparent that the City of Yelm's approach to water resource planning fails to protect the public interest and that an Environmental Impact Statement should be required to protect the local aquifer.

An MDNS (Mitigated Determination of Non-Significance) should not substitute for an EIS (Environmental Impact Study).

Please hold the City of Yelm accountable to its citizens that live within the city limits and the surrounding communities by insuring their proposed increase in water withdrawal will not adversely effect the community.

Insure the public interest is protected by protecting our local aquifer.
