## City of Yelm Notice of Public Hearing

The City of Yelm has scheduled a public hearing to receive public comment on Resolution Number 514, adopting the 2008 to 2015 Water System Plan. The hearing is scheduled for the regular City Council meeting at 7:00 PM on Tuesday, July 27, 2010, at the Yelm Public Safety Building located at 206 McKenzie Street SE, Yelm, WA.

As a water purveyor regulated by the Washington State Department of Health, the City of Yelm is required to update its Water System Plan every 6 years. As defined by Health, the principal goal of water system planning is to make the best use of the City's resources in order to provide high-quality service and protect the health of its customers.

The draft plan being considered for adoption covers 6- and 20-year planning periods. A schedule of improvements has been developed for both planning horizons, along with a financial program for the 6-year period, consisting of increased monthly water rates and system development (connect) charges. Planning assumptions utilized the most recent population projections for Yelm recently completed by the Thurston Regional Planning Council (TRPC) as adopted by Thurston County.

It is the City of Yelm's policy to provide reasonable accommodations for people with disabilities.
